Remarks upon deaths of relatives; funeral procession from Llanidloes to Llanbadarn Fawr, co Cardigan, stuck in snow; upon wild animals and birds; weather; natural history; Dolwen Bridge broken down and its rebuilding; Severn floods; death of Emperor of Russia; killing rats and rooks; fishing; excavations of Roman sites at Carno and Caersws; visit to Newtown in the "Mermaid" dog-cart; collection for Church Missionary Society; visit to Llanidloes vicarage and stay at "Queen's Head"; Bible Society meetings at Llanidloes and Llandinam; butterflies' attendance of brother Clement as boarder at Benbow's school in Pool Road, Newtown; killing of a hare; pending start at school in Llandovery.
