

**Powys County Council (Various Streets Llanrhaeadr YM)  
(Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 2018**

**Statement of Reasons**

Following the introduction of Civil Parking Enforcement by Powys County Council it was agreed that on street parking reviews would be carried out on a town/village by town/village basis as and where required and justified.

A review of the existing waiting prohibitions on the county highways within the village of Llanrhaeadr YM has been undertaken with the Community Council and the local County Councillor.

Problem locations have been identified over a period of time by the local bus service operator, the police, the community council and the local member.

A number of meetings and discussions have taken place to identify where prohibitions need to be modified to address nuisance and inconsiderate parking within the village.

Proposal plans to address these concerns have been drawn up and considered by the community council and the local member; and subsequently modified to accommodate requested revisions which were supported by the local highway authority.

The community council and the local member have expressed their support for the extents of the modified waiting proposals.

**Proposal**

The proposed prohibition of waiting restrictions within the village are identified on the attached plan.

The proposals are intended to manage traffic flows, and prohibit waiting at locations on the public highway where safe vehicle and pedestrian movements would otherwise be compromised.

A plan identifying the location of the existing on street waiting prohibitions is also attached for cross reference.

At their meeting of 6<sup>th</sup> September 2017, the Montgomeryshire Committee resolved to support the draft proposals, and instructed the local highway authority to commence the legal consultation procedures for the proposed traffic regulation order, and if no substantive objections are received, authorised the traffic engineer to implement the proposal.
