### REPORTING MOVEMENTS OF SHEEP/PIGS/GOATS ONTO THE SHOWGROUND

The **Show Secretary** or other **Authorised Person** must report **all** movements of Sheep, Goats and Pigs **onto** the Showground to the **Local Authority**

These animals must arrive with the appropriate paperwork – a movement document AML1 for Sheep and Goats; an AML2 for pigs

- ❖ The Exhibitor must pass the **PINK** and **WHITE** copies to the Authorised Representative of the show
- ❖ Sections A & B should have been completed in full by the Exhibitor and **ALL Animals Individually Identified**. See example below.

**Sheep/Goats** UK 123456-01 or S12345-01  
Generally UK or S + 6-figure number + further individual number

**Pigs** A1234-01 or WG1234-01  
One or two letters + 4-figure number + further individual number

- ❖ Section C should have the Showground entered as the Destination and any remaining detail within Sections C & D must be completed by the Show Secretary or Authorised Representative including the Signature
- ❖ The **PINK** copy to be retained by the Show Secretary for a period of 6 months
- ❖ It is the responsibility of the Show Secretary to forward the **WHITE** copy within 3 days to :-

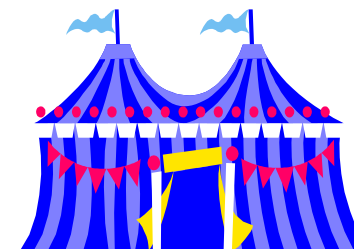
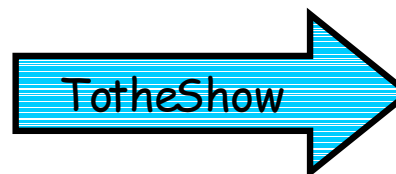
### REPORTING MOVEMENTS OF CATTLE ONTO THE SHOWGROUND

The **Show Secretary** or other **Authorised Person** must report **all** movements of Cattle **onto** the Showground to the **British Cattle Movement Service (BCMS)**

Cattle arriving at the showground must be accompanied by their Individual Passport

- ❖ In the Cattle Passport of each individual animal are movement notification slips, one of which the Show Secretary or his Representative must remove from the passport and complete indicating that the animal has been received onto the showground
- ❖ The Showground bar-code sticker must be attached to the notification slip (these can be obtained from BCMS)
- ❖ The **Show Secretary** or his **Representative** must post this movement notification slip within 3 days to:-

## REPORTING MOVEMENTS OF SHEEP/PIGS/GOATS AWAY FROM THE SHOWGROUND

The **Show Secretary** will need to have **supplies of the Form AML1 Movement Document for Sheep and Goats** and **AML2 Movement Document for Pigs**, because the show animals will need a document completing for the return movement home

specifying the type of animal and approximate number of exhibitors

**Section A:** the Departure CPH is that of the Showground the keeper will be the Show Secretary ie the temporary keeper/contact for the Departure site) the Premises of Departure, the Show Title and location the official Individual Identification of the animals must be supplied the Show Secretary or Representative must sign at Section A in confirmation of details entered

**Section C** The Show Secretary must ensure that the **Destination Address** is completed whilst **all copies of the document are still attached**

The **YELLOW** copy is to be kept by the Show Secretary for a period of 6 months

The **PINK, BLUE** and **WHITE** copies are to be passed to the person transporting the animals (there is no requirement for the Show Secretary to notify the Local Authority of a movement away from the Show Ground)

### Sections B, C & D

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor to notify of the return movement by completing the remaining detail in Sections B, C & D and forwarding the **WHITE** copy to their own Local Authority within 3 days of the movement

## REPORTING MOVEMENTS OF CATTLE AWAY FROM THE SHOWGROUND

The **Show Secretary** will need to know approximately **how many** bovine animals are being exhibited, because **twice this number of Showground bar-code stickers will be needed** (one for the movement onto the showground and one for the movement away from the Showground)

Please also confirm with BCMS that the details held on record for the **Show Secretary** are **Accurate**

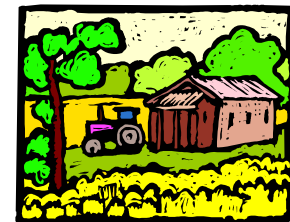
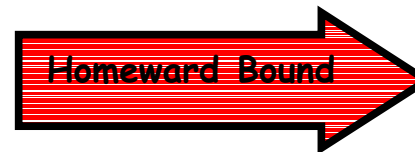
Within the Cattle Passport of each animal, are movement notification slips, one of which the Show Secretary or his Representative must remove from the passport and complete indicating that the animal has left/is leaving the Showground

The Show Secretary or his Representative must apply the Showground bar-code sticker to the notification slip

The Show Secretary or his Representative must post this movement notification slip within 3 days to:

**BCMS. Curwen Road, Wokington, Cumbria, CA14 2DD**

The Exhibitor will confirm to BCMS the return of his animals onto his holding by completing a further slip which he forwards to BCMS
