Dear Tracy Smith,

I am writing in response to this email. Unfortunately I do not seem to have received the previous email, perhaps due to the cyber-attack interference or the periods of down time when our County Councillor lap tops were not functioning. I had reported this problem in County hall on Friday, following an earlier period of disconnection, so I apologise for the delay in my reply.

I wish you to note my previous concerns and that these have in part diminished in view of the proposed reduction of the LSAs for onshore Wind. However I note with some concern that the number of Local Search Areas for solar remains at 33, despite the fact that the Enplan Landscape Sensitivity Study of May 2017 recommends that 11 of these areas have no potential for locating solar development without significant landscape and visual harm' and that 2 areas have very limited potential. Is this not taking a step back to suggest that little or no notice needs to be taken in what might be considered unlikely areas for development. I am particularly concerned about S24 Little Hill, South east of Hundred House and S25 Aberedw Hill.

I hope that these issues within the potential plan will receive some attention from the Inspector, with a view to possible exclusion from the revised Local Development Plan, and that all Sites of Special Scientific Interest and European Protected Areas will now be excluded from the Local Search Areas to be considered within the LDP.
