

Builth and Llanwrtyd Locality Focus

Builth and Llanwrtyd Population

The **current population is 6,811** ¹ The **average age of people in the locality is 46 years** (Powys average 46).

Females make up 51% of the population of the area, and **males 49%**

25.6% of the population are **over 65** (Powys average is 25.8%), whilst people **over 85** make up 3.3% of the population (Powys average is 3.4%). Overall the population is expected to **decrease by 6.2%** by 2036 (from 6,811 in 2015 to 6,391; **Powys average is 6% decrease**). In contrast, the **over 85** population is expected to rise steeply, with the population moving **by 139.3%** from 228 to 546 over the same period.

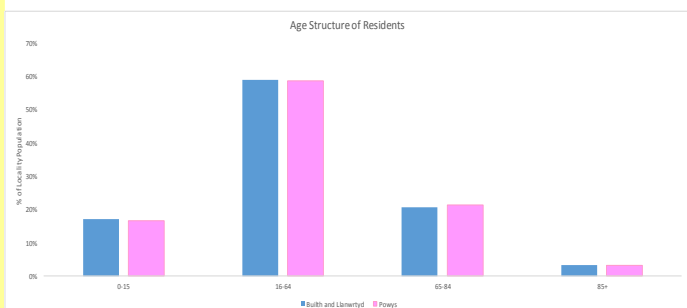
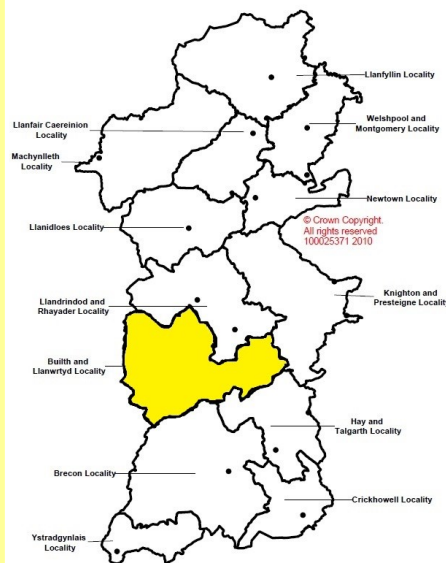
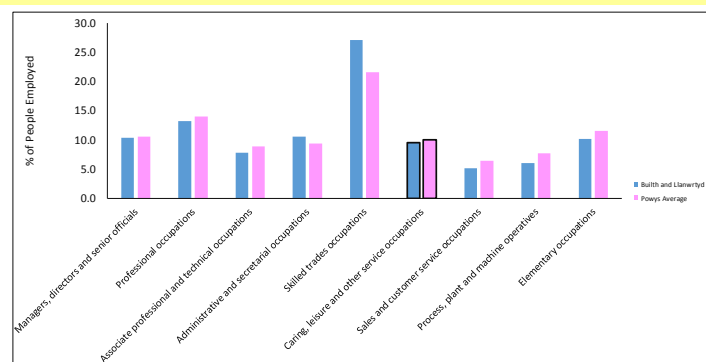

Access to Services

Higher than average travel time to an NHS Dentist (58 minutes, Powys Average 55 minutes) and GP surgery (56 minutes, Powys Average 50 minutes)³.

Residents Satisfaction⁴

- 24% of residents feel satisfied with **care for older people/the elderly** this locality (average for all Powys Localities = 28%)
- 86% of residents feel satisfied that this locality is a place where people **look out for and support each other** (average for all Powys Localities = 81%)
- 92% of residents in this locality say that they or a family member participate (either regularly or sometimes) in **local community events and activities** (average for all Powys Localities = 84%)

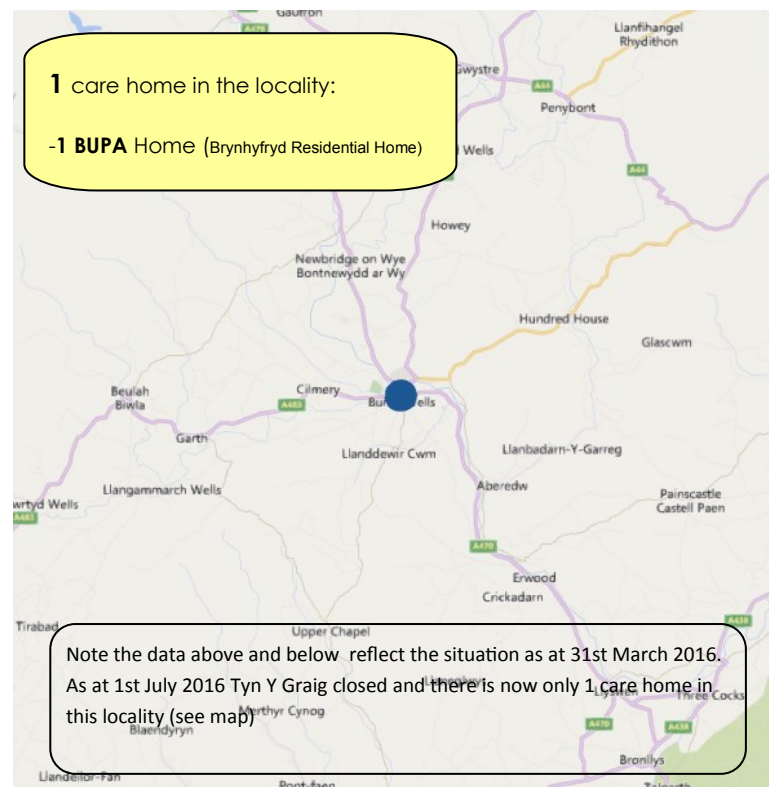

What are we currently providing and what are the costs?

During the last year, 38 people resided in homes in this locality (as at 1st August 2016) all of which were Older/Frail clients. 25 of those clients were female and 13 were male.

Residents of care homes in the locality over the last year have an **average Length of stay of 576 days** and an **average age at admission of 84** years (Bupa = 85 Non Bupa = 81)(as at 1st August 2016)

Conditions Summary

The authority has undertaken a 10 year residential home conditions survey programme (from 2009 – 2018) to calculate the investment required in Brynhyfyd. Based on 2009 costs a total investment of [REDACTED] will be required.

Domiciliary Care Provision

Currently we provide **700 hours of Domiciliary Care** in this locality (**102 per 1,000 population**) to **59 clients** (as at 1st August 2016).

Where do care home residents come from?

23 residents (65% of total) were previously living in the **Builth and Llanwrtyd** locality

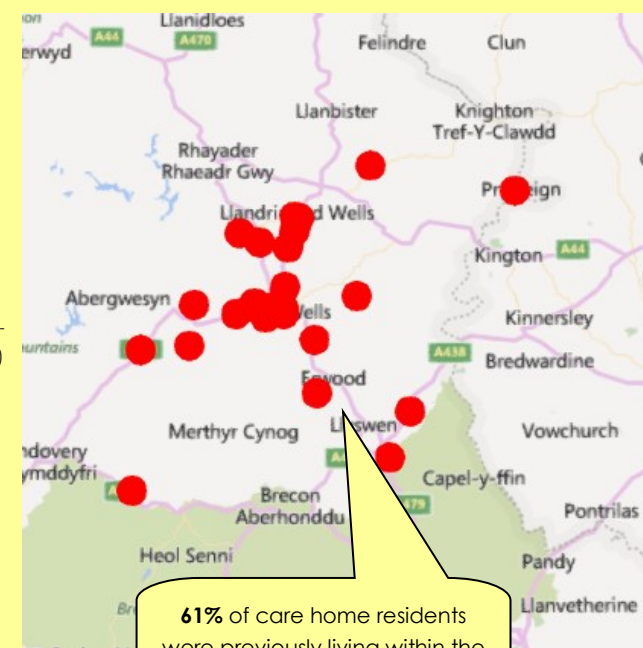
12 were living in other localities :
