

Want to try out real nappies?

Powys County Council is offering an incentive of up to £100, so that you can!



Eligibility

You can claim if:

- You're a parent or carer
- You've purchased real nappies or real nappy accessories to the value of £50 or more in the last six months and you have kept your receipt
- You haven't yet bought your real nappies or real nappy accessories but would like to purchase real nappies – don't forget to keep your receipt

Where to get them

You can go to any retailer.

How you get your money

If you are eligible, payment will be made by bank transfer. Once your application has been approved a BACS form requesting your bank details will be sent to you.

Terms & Conditions

1. *Applications will only be accepted from residents of Powys.*
2. *Only one application per household will be accepted.*
3. *Receipts, including online order confirmations, must clearly show real nappies have been purchased. This can also include real nappy accessories but these cannot be the sole purchase. It is the responsibility of the applicant to ensure this is clearly visible on the receipt. Receipts not showing this will not be accepted. Online order confirmations must show the date, retailer and evidence that payment has been made. Original receipts must be submitted. Receipts must be no more than six months old.*
4. *We require a Birth Certificate or a MAT B1 which must be legible and have no alterations. Only copies of certificates must be sent as they cannot be returned.*
5. *Powys County Council cannot accept responsibility for the loss of any application howsoever caused.*
6. *You can obtain a Proof of Posting certificate free from the Post Office.*
7. *Powys County Council reserves the right to withhold payment if it is felt that any of the conditions above have not been satisfied.*
8. *Maximum claim is £100*
9. *Minimum claim is £50*

10. Dim ond ceisiadau gan drigolion Powys fyddwn ni'n eu derbyn.
11. Dim ond un cais fyddwn ni'n ei dderbyn ar gyfer pob aelwyd.
12. Rhaid i dderbynebau, gan gynnwys cadarnhad o archebu'r cewynnau ar-lein, ddangos yn eglur eich bod wedi prynu cewynnau go iawn. Gall hyn hefyd gynnwys ategolion cewynnau go iawn, ond rhaid i'r rhain beidio â bod yn bryniant ar e ben ei hun.
