

What is happening?

Powys County Council, the organisation which decides how education is organised and provided in Powys, has to regularly review the way education is organised and provided, to make sure that all children and young people have the chance to go to schools that give them the best possible chances for when they grow up.

We've recently been reviewing Ladywell Green and Hafren Schools in Newtown. These two schools are located on the same site. Pupils go to Ladywell Green School from ages 4 to 7, and then go to Hafren School from ages 7 to 11. This is different to most pupils in Powys and Wales. Most pupils start at primary school when they are 4 years old, and stay in the same school until they are 11.

We're wondering whether it would be better if Ladywell Green and Hafren schools were merged together, to create one new primary school, located in the current buildings.

We want to know what you think about this idea.

What would change?

All pupils in Ladywell Green and Hafren Schools would be part of one school. There would be one headteacher, a new school name, and possibly a new school uniform.

The school would be in the Ladywell Green and Hafren buildings - as pupils, you would still go to school in the same buildings as you do now. Pupils up to Year 2 would still go to the current site of Ladywell Green Infants School, and pupils from Year 3 onwards would go to the current site of Hafren School.

What will happen next?

This is only an idea at the moment. We want to know what people think about this idea. We'll read all the comments sent in, and decide whether or not to carry on.

If we want to carry on, we'll have to publish something called a 'Statutory Notice' to say what we want to do. There would then be another chance for people to tell us if they don't think this should happen.
